

## Camper Packing List

Camping at Ross Camp can bring warm, hot, cool, sunny, rain, hail and more. Plan to watch the weather forecast prior to camp so that you can pack accordingly. The following is a list of suggested items. Keep in mind that most of the time spent at camp is outdoors. Expensive designer clothing should be left at home—**bring clothes that can get dirty!!!! Make sure all items are marked with your camper's name (first and last name). We get a lot of leftover clothing each year, so please mark your camper's clothing and gear.**

### What to Bring:

- Boots, lace up gym shoes or good sturdy shoes for hiking. We do a lot of walking at camp. **Although flip flops are popular, they cause blisters when worn constantly. Closed toed shoes for canoeing.**
- Raincoat or poncho
- Hat with sunvisor, sunglasses
- Several pairs of socks (it is a good idea to bring extra), long pants or sweat pants and shorts, short sleeved-shirts and long sleeved shirts, sweater or sweatshirt, swim suit (no string bikinis or speedos), pajamas, underwear
- **DARK CLOTHING FOR NIGHT WALK.** No white writing or stripes
- Lip balm, sunscreen, mosquito spray
- Soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, baby powder
- Flip flops for shower house—**MAKE SURE YOU SEND LACE UP SHOES FOR HIKING**
- 2 towels (one for bath house and one extra), washcloth and face towel
- **Bedding—Twin sized sheets (fitted & flat), pillow, blanket and sleeping bag (each group will tent camp one night);**
- Notebook and pen or pencil for note taking in classes
- Trunk or suit case to store clothing in. If you have a key, bring an extra for chief of area
- Flashlight and extra batteries
- Plastic bags for garbage and wet clothing
- White shirt or neon colors for Black Light Party
- Bandanas for Pirate night
- Beach Party night
- Fantasy night—wizards, dragons, princess, knights, kings, queens
- 2 Old t-shirts for craft

### DO NOT BRING:

- Video games, cell phones, other electronic games, ipods, Hair dryers, hair straighteners, curling irons, irons, electric fan (battery fans allowed), fireworks, matches or lighters, pocket knives, food
- Tylenol, Benadryl, cough syrup, allergy medicine or over the counter medicine as they are provided by the camp nurse if needed.
